- Two colleges in Virudhunagar district can register as members in this programme as and when the search 100th meet in Physics.




This Agreement made and entered into on this 07th day of June 2019 between Department of Chemistry, Sri Sri Rama Kishoreya College situated at Anapurathur (PIN: 626002), Anaparthur Block and Sri Magathy Chemical Traders, Nambakkal Nagar, Anaparthur.

- Department of Chemistry, Sri Sri Rama Kishoreya College, Incorporated conducting a practical course on "Self employment small scale industrial products manufacturing processes" funded by centrally funded Commission, New Delhi.
- The course is conducted with the affiliation of Madurai University, Madurai.
- The main aim of conducting the course is to gain knowledge about small scale industrial manufacturing processes and procedures and among Faculty and student community in our college Anaparthur.
- The course structure covers theory, practical and industrial product training.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is

- a. To provide industrial practical training to certificate course students in mutually beneficial areas.
- b. To provide a formal link for existing interaction between Sri Sri Rama Kishoreya College and Sri Magathy Chemical Traders.

3. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION

Sri Sri Rama Kishoreya College and Sri Magathy Chemical Traders propose to collaborate through

- a. Sponsorship practical training to students a UGC sponsored certificate course from the year 2019 onwards.
- b. Training of industry personnel through Continuing Education Programmes conducted by Sri Sri Rama Kishoreya College in areas related to Sri Magathy Chemical Traders.

Each of the above modes of interaction will be initiated by entering into a separate agreement between the two parties.

3. AGREEMENTS FOR TRAINING COLLABORATION

Training collaboration undertaken by the parties hereunder shall be initiated by the signing of a separate agreement between the parties, which will describe in detail

- a. Party 1 is obligated to give practical industrial training to the certificate course students in respect of their manufacturing products in Sri Magathy Chemical Traders.
- b. It is also allowed by both parties that there are no financial relation between them.
- c. Other provisions as may be mutually agreed upon, including provisions covering the consequences of withdrawal or termination by a particular party, extension of duration and withdrawal fee.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY

During a period of five years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to provide as confidential all information disclosed to the other party in writing or verbally here on, if such information is received or written after the date of disclosure, and classified as confidential in

5. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be non-exclusive and both parties, including their officers, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations if any such.

6. TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MOU enters automatically into a written agreement of the parties, that expire 2 years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be extended or terminated orally by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU after 90 days prior written notice to the other party. Confidentiality clause in this document is in force if there is any other agreement entered into pursuant to this MOU, which obligations shall survive the said termination.

7. REPRESENTATION

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed to make any party a partner, an agent or legal representative of the other for any purpose.

8. SIGNATURES
